"My name is Candy. My story at the Healing House began on November 1, 2021. Last September I had my first encounter with Metro Hope at a statewide recovery walk. During this time I had mentioned that I wish I'd known about them sooner, before I lost the rights to my other 5 kiddos the year prior.

October 2021, I had my sentencing after being out of custody for 18 months. Little did I know that shortly after I would find out I was unexpectedly pregnant. Not sure how I was going to be able to keep this child with my new felony convictions, one being child neglect without harm, probabtion conditions in regards to caring for children, as well as my previous Termination of Parental Rights. When I reached out to Metro Hope I did not have much hope but was willing to do anything. At the time, I was already in intensive outpatient treatment and in sober living. The Director of Healing House said they don't typically take women at 7 months into recovery but she saw too many reasons to say yes.

May 24, 2022, I gave birth to my 6th child, Malachi. My first miracle was walking through the Healing House doors with my baby in my arms. Less than 24 hours later I received a call from Child Protection saying they needed to come see the baby. I was scared. Thankfully, the amazing staff prayed with me as well as met with the investigator prior to her coming to my room. That day the investigator said she didn't see any immediate concerns. Fast forward a few weeks, I received another call from the investigator saying she had no concerns and wanted to commend me for all of the hard work I'd done the last 15 months. She said she could tell I had done a lot to turn my life around.

If it were not for Metro Hope I am not sure where I would be today. I was given hope where I had none to have a second chance at being a mom. I am so grateful that Malachi and I can continue living at Healing House for up to 2 years. It is a safety net and support even though I graduated from the program 3 weeks after having my baby. Child Protection went smoothly because I was here, I didn't even have to go through the court system this time. I had an easy transition from investigation to case management so now for the next 6 months Child Protection will check in on us monthly.

God truly did the impossible, thanks to Metro Hope Ministries, and for that I am finally starting to believe in good

things again!"
